Becoming dry with evening sunshine, then clear periods tonight for most. Cloudiest in the far east. Chilly.

Outlook for Tuesday:
Largely sunny start, cloud generally increasing. Still fine with sunny spells for most. Rain in far W.Cornwall and N.Ireland/W.Scotland later.
