

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally cloudy, with persistent rain across western Scotland, and some outbreaks of light rain in other western parts. Elsewhere should be dry with occasional sunny spells. Breezy with some strong gusts over northeast England and southeast Scotland, but mild. Wet and windy conditions will push east across most parts tonight with clearer, colder conditions following. Turning showery in the northwest.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Early rain should clear southeast England by lunchtime. Otherwise sunny spells and blustery showers are expected on Friday, with some heavy and squally showers, wintry over northern hills. Wet and windy on Saturday with some gales, turning more showery later.
