

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of rain, locally heavy, will clear away northeastwards this morning, except taking until this evening to clear Shetland. Sunshine and showers will follow, showers mainly to western and central areas, before heavy rain arrives across Northern Ireland later. Temperatures will be close to normal. Overnight central and eastern England staying largely dry, showers or spells of rain elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The weather will remain unsettled with bands of rain, often heavy, sweeping eastwards across the UK over the weekend. In-between the bands of rain there will be broken cloud and showers, allowing some sunny spells to occur. Windy on Sunday.
