Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Most places will be cloudy, dull and hazy. Frost and fog will be slow to clear and may linger in some parts. A few bright or sunny intervals are likely, chiefly in northeast Scotland. Feeling cold.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday, most districts cloudy and dull, a little rain in northwest Scotland. Frost and fog slow to clear. Northeast Scotland, perhaps southwest England, should see the best of any sun. Friday, rain and drizzle across northwestern parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland. Elsewhere, mostly cloudy, frost and fog slow to clear, perhaps drizzle on eastern coasts. A few bright or sunny intervals.
