

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 20 Dec 2006

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Dull and cold in many places today, with fog or low cloud persisting. Where the fog lingers, locally dense and freezing, temperatures may not rise above freezing. However, northeast Scotland and Cornwall will remain largely fine. Tonight far north and northwest of Scotland dry and largely cloudy. Elsewhere the fog and low cloud will become more extensive again.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thickening cloud will bring outbreaks of rain to northwest Scotland. Elsewhere mainly dry, with just a little drizzle in places, cold and dull. Areas of low cloud or fog persisting, fog locally dense and freezing, especially across England and Wales.
