Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A lot of cloud across southern England and Wales and also the far north of Scotland with patchy light rain and drizzle. In between, dry and bright, but cooler and less sunny than Thursday. Breezy in the south. Similar conditions overnight with a patchy frost and fog forming in any prolonged clear spells.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Saturday, mainly dry with areas of cloud and sunny spells, mainly in the west. Scotland will continue cloudy with patchy rain or drizzle. Chilly in south. Mostly dry on Sunday but rather cloudy once more. The best of any sunshine in southwestern parts and the far north.
