

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, rain in the northeast, turning to snow as cold northerly winds develop. Brighter and drier further southwest. Elsewhere, bright or sunny spells but rather cloudy at times with rain or showers, turning wintry on northern hills later. Tonight, light, wintry showers continuing near some North Sea coasts but, elsewhere, isolated showers and widespread frost, despite a brisk northerly wind.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday, showers at times in the far southeast. Otherwise mostly dry and sunny. Cold with a widespread frost early and late. Saturday, bright in the southeast but rain, heavy at times, sweeping southeastwards through the day. Very windy at times.
