Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
England and Wales cloudy, with outbreaks of rain or drizzle, becoming  
brighter with sunny spells in north later. Good spells of sunshine  
over Scotland and Northern Ireland, with showers for a time and  
decreasing winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday, the south of England and Wales cloudy and misty with  
drizzle. Northern Ireland and northern Scotland also cloudy and  
increasingly windy. Elsewhere, frost and fog slow to clear and  
feeling cold. Thursday, most places cloudy. A few spots of rain and  
windy over Northern Ireland and western Scotland, later over  
southwest England. Feeling cold, with snow flurries inland and a  
southeasterly breeze picking up.
