Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A fine but very cold day today after a frosty start across the country with a risk of icy patches mainly in the southwest of England. Staying largely dry overnight tonight with a widespread hard frost quickly returning nationwide. A few wintry showers also possibly developing towards the east coast of England later in the night.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Staying very cold but largely fine and dry throughout Thursday and Friday. A few snow showers will spread into eastern parts at times, especially overnight Thursday and into Friday. Both nights will also see a widespread hard frost develop across the country.
