

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Patchy rain in the far southwest will clear during the morning. Isolated showers may also develop through the day, possibly heavy, mainly in northern England and Wales. It will otherwise be largely dry with warm sunny spells for most. Dry and fine with long clear spells overnight, with an isolated shallow mist patch possible. Becoming cloudier in the far northwest.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A fragmenting rain band, with strengthening winds will move slowly southeast, reaching southern Scotland and Northern Ireland by evening on Wednesday. Elsewhere, remaining dry and fine, with sunny spells and feeling warm. Thursday will be similar, with a northwest-southeast split.
