Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a frosty start, much of the UK will be dry through Monday with some prolonged sunny spells. Showers will affect some eastern counties that will be locally wintry, especially over higher ground. Winds will continue to ease through the day. Despite this, it will stay cold across the country.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Staying dry for most with sunny spells. Across eastern counties, there is the continued risk of wintry showers, turning increasingly to snow, even at low levels. Remaining cold across the UK with widespread overnight frost, icy patches following any showers, and freezing fog patches that may be slow to clear.
