

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will clear southeast England this afternoon, with a mixture of sunshine and showers following across the UK. These showers will be most frequent in the north and west, with some snow likely over hills here, and to lower levels in western Scotland. These showers will continue in the northwest overnight, but otherwise it will be fine but chilly.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It will be a fine start for most on Thursday, but it will become increasingly cloudy, with showers in the northwest replaced by light rain. It will remain generally cloudy on Friday, with further spells of rain, particularly across western parts.
