for the period 0000 UTC Tuesday 03 November to 0000 UTC Wednesday 04 November  
2015

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will maintain settled conditions across most northern parts of the United Kingdom during the next 24 hours, although a weather front will spread some outbreaks of rain northwards across England and Wales.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, occasionally southwesterly 5 near Cape Wrath and Rattray Head. Moderate or rough to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight, but occasionally moderate near Rattray Head.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Moderate to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming south 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Rain then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fog patches at first, occasional rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east, decreasing 3 at times in west.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair then rain at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeasterly 3 or 4 veering southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis  
24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair then rain at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast veering southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly veering southeasterly 4 or 5, then becoming variable 2 or 3 in west.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near the Isles of Scilly.  
Fair then rain at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 at first in west, otherwise southeasterly veering southwesterly 4 or 5, then backing southerly 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate in east, moderate in west.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, then veering southwesterly 3 or 4 later in south.  
Slight or moderate.

Fair then rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeasterly at first in north, otherwise southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable at first in north, otherwise easterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.  
Rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Easterly veering westerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in south.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 4 or 5, backing east or northeast 3 or 4 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate at first in northwest.  
Fog patches at first, occasional rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East or northeast veering southeast, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then backing northeast later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.  
Fog patches at first, rain at times later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeast 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3.  
Smooth or slight.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or less later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.  
Fair then rain at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

#### Channel

##### 24 hour forecast:

South backing southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then backing east 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly east 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

#### The Minch - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or drizzle at times, mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming east or northeast, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

#### Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

##### 24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming easterly or northeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Tuesday 03 Nov 2015 at 0000 UTC until Tuesday 03 Nov 2015 at 1200 UTC

#### Shetland Isles

##### General Situation

Various weak troughs move over Shetland area from the west, with ridge building into western waters later Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in northwest, veering southwesterly 4 or 5.  
Moderate or rough, but slight in shelter east of Shetland.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, mist, risk of fog patches in east.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor, perhaps very poor at times in east.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 03 Nov until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 04 Nov:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough, but slight in shelter east of Shetland.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, perhaps mist at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to southeast 4 to 5, locally 6, decreasing 3 to 4 for a time in the afternoon, veering southwest later.  
Slight to moderate.  
Isolated showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 2 to 4, increasing 4 occasionally 5 Wednesday morning, backing south in the evening.  
Slight locally moderate, with swell.  
Isolated showers, dying out by afternoon.  
Good, occasionally moderate in showers.

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
