Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Dry and bright in many places with some sunshine at times, the best of this in eastern districts. Some showers are likely across parts of northern and western Scotland at first, and also affecting parts of northwest England. During the afternoon, outbreaks of rain will spread across the northwest of Scotland, reaching remaining parts of Scotland by early evening. Temperatures near normal after a locally chilly start and, with light winds, feeling quite pleasant in the sunshine.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Mostly cloudy on Saturday with rain or drizzle in many places away from the southwest. Still mostly cloudy on Sunday but mainly dry.
