Headline:

Rain/sleet/snow moving from Midlands southwards. Brighter conditions behind.

Today:

Sleet or snow across the Midlands spreading over southeast England with rain following. Icy patches likely. Brighter, drier weather in north gradually extending to all areas.

Tonight:

Mostly dry with patchy frost. Showers across northern Scotland extending down North Sea coasts overnight, with wintry falls in places.

Outlook for Saturday:

Outbreaks rain, sleet or snow in east, sometimes heavy. Drier and brighter in west.
