Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain, heavy at times and wintry over hills, will move south through Scotland and into England with colder, clearer conditions following, as well as some showers. This reaching the south-west peninsular and the south-east midlands by dawn. Ahead of this it'll be largely dry with variable cloud.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Rain will be slow to clear the south of England on Sunday. Further north, it will be cold with some brighter spells but also some wintry showers. Cold but largely dry with widespread sunshine on Monday, aside from the far north where it will be wet, with strong winds.
