Headline:

Cloudy start, then mostly dry, sunny spells. Showers in northeast.

Today:

Grey start, then mainly dry with some sunshine. A few showers in the north and east. Generally rather warm.

Tonight:

Mostly cloudy, clearest in southwest. Patchy rain in east. Widespread mist, some fog. Light winds.

Outlook for Saturday:

Cool and cloudy with mist and patchy rain in east. Rather warm with sunny spells elsewhere, but scattered showers developing. Becoming breezy and wet over Cornwall.
