Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most areas will have bright or sunny intervals and scattered showers, these heavy in the east. Much of northeastern England and eastern Scotland will have continuous rain but most western areas will be dry and bright. Tonight showers will gradually die away and the continuous rain will eventually become confined to eastern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

There will be a few showers on Monday, mostly in central and northern areas, but most places will be dry and bright. After a bright start in the east rain will move in from the west on Tuesday, although it will become brighter in the west later.
