

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Continuing dry with sunny, then clear, spells in many locations, the best of these across northern and western parts of the United Kingdom. Low cloud across East Anglia, Lincolnshire and the Midlands, burning back to the coast during the morning, but returning during Thursday evening. Rather warm or warm for many parts, much cooler near coasts, especially North Sea coasts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday most places dry with sunny spells though eastern parts cloudy initially, and rain spreading into Northern Ireland and northwestern Scotland later. On Saturday rain will spread east across all parts followed by mainly dry conditions with sunny periods.
