

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 07 Apr 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain, locally heavy, crossing much of England, Wales and southern Scotland, clearing gradually eastwards. Becoming brighter from the northwest, but with heavy showers affecting some northern and western parts. Tonight, rain in the east, heavy at times, will gradually clear. Otherwise, clear spells and scattered showers, some heavy in the north and west, and wintry over high ground.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Bright and breezy on Tuesday with sunny spells and scattered showers, although many southern and eastern areas will remain dry. Dry and fine in the south Wednesday, but cloud and patchy rain in the north will slowly edge southwards through the day.
