Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland and Northern Ireland remain windy with a mix of sunny spells and scattered showers, with some of these showers becoming heavy over the west of Scotland. Rain will affect Wales and parts of west, central and northeast England today, but this eases as it clears southeastwards overnight. Elsewhere it will be mainly dry but rather cloudy at times.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Most parts will be cloudy on Thursday with rain at times, although it becomes drier and brighter later. It will be dry and sunny at first on Friday but the north and west become wet and windy during the morning.
