Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Cloud and outbreaks of rain clearing from south and east England during the morning with sunny spells developing. Showers over north and east Scotland, but becoming more isolated further southwest. Generally dry elsewhere with sunny spells. Winds generally light to moderate northwesterly. Temperatures generally near or a little above normal, but feeling rather cool in showers in the north.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Generally dry on both days with sunny spells, but some showers are likely over the north and east of Scotland and northeast England. Also thicker cloud and patchy rain or drizzle may affect southwest England and southwest Wales at times.
