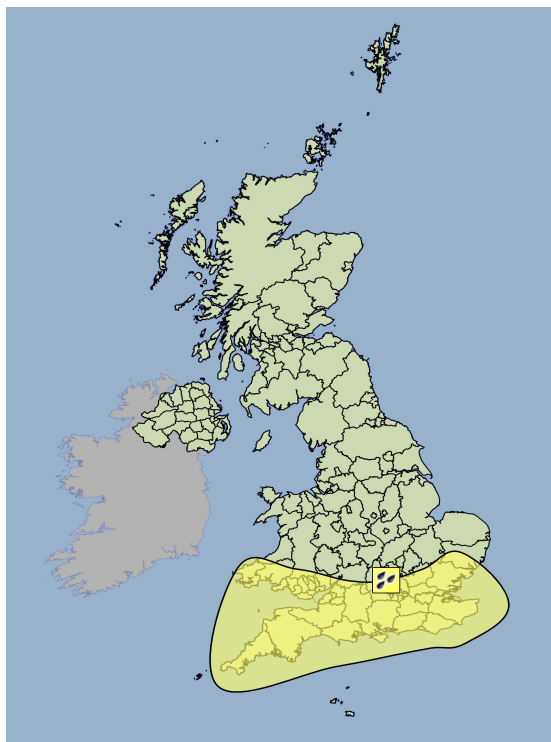




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

A complex area of low pressure looks like bringing an unpleasant day's weather to much of the south on Monday. Rainfall amounts look like exceeding 20 mm quite widely, while a few places might see around 40 mm, so there will be a lot of surface water and spray on roads. The spray will probably be made worse by strong winds across some southern area; gusts to around 40 mph may occur at some coastal locations although this will depend on the exact track of the low pressure.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Rain**

Valid from **06:00 on Mon, 25th Aug 2014** until **23:50 on Mon, 25th Aug 2014**

Heavy rain is expected to affect many southern areas of Britain at times during Bank Holiday Monday, with strong winds a possible additional factor close to southern coasts.

The public should be aware that there may be some impacts to holiday traffic and other outdoor activities.
