Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of occasionally rain will spread across parts of Northern Ireland and southern Scotland today, extending to Wales and western areas of England this afternoon. Very warm or hot and dry in the south and east. Cloud and rain extending to all parts overnight. Rain will be heavy at times in the north of England and Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Outbreaks of heavy rain will continue across parts of Scotland with brisk northerly wind developing. Becoming brighter with sunny spells and scattered showers across England and Wales. Showers locally heavy with thunder. Bright spells and further scattered thundery showers are expected on Tuesday.
