Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Bitterly cold with freezing fog patches and severe frost. Snow or snow showers over Scotland and Northern Ireland will spread to northern England later. Dry and bright further south, but cold with freezing fog patches slow to clear. Overnight, mainly light snow or snow showers in northern areas with slight accumulations. Dry and frosty further south with freezing fog patches.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Further wintry flurries in the north and west. Much of England and Wales dry and frosty with freezing fog patches. Wintry showers in the north on Wednesday, mainly dry in the south with broken cloud and bright spells. Frosty overnight.
