

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Bitterly cold at first, with a widespread frost and fog in places. Outbreaks of sleet and snow are expected across northwestern areas. Elsewhere will be mostly dry with some sunshine. Overnight, outbreaks of rain, sleet and snow will spread to remaining areas, becoming drier towards dawn. Temperatures will be very cold with ice in places.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Outbreaks of rain, sleet and hill snow are expected to cross southern England and Wales, clearing southwards on Sunday. Elsewhere it will be mainly dry with sunny spells, apart from a few wintry showers in the north. Remaining cold, but slightly less so on Saturday.
