Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Outbreaks of rain and sunny spells in Wales and western England. Rain soon reaching Northern Ireland, crossing Scotland during day. Central and eastern England staying dry, sunny, becoming very warm in places. Mist, low cloud developing on eastern coasts and English Channel coasts, chiefly in west, spreading inland in places. Southeasterly winds, quite fresh at times.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday, central districts of England and Scotland becoming drier and brighter as rain moves to the east. Wales and the west mostly dry and bright, but Northern Ireland more cloudy. Saturday, mostly cloudy with outbreaks of rain, locally heavy and perhaps thundery.
