

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 27 Jul 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a fine and warm morning for many, thickening cloud in the south will start to bring heavy, and in places, persistent rain northwards later, locally torrential and thundery in the southeast. Scattered heavy showers will also develop further north ahead of the rain. The rain moves northwards overnight, becoming drier in the south later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Heavy and persistent rain over much of Scotland will only gradually clear northwards during Sunday, with sunshine and scattered heavy showers elsewhere, mostly in the west. Feeling a little less warm on Monday due to moderate winds, with bright spells and scattered thundery showers again.
