

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 08 Sep 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A wet start for southeast England, with persistent and occasionally heavy rain. This should clear to the east by late afternoon leaving patchy rain and showers. Northeast Scotland will see persistent light rain for much of the day, but sunshine and showers are expected elsewhere with the best of the sunshine in the west. Winds should be mainly light.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday should be a much drier day with plenty of sunshine and only a scattering of mainly light showers, but some persistent rain is expected over northwestern parts of the UK on Friday. Winds should be generally light to moderate throughout.
