Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most areas will have a sunny but cold day, although a few showers will affect some northern and eastern coasts. Western areas will have the most cloud, and rain will spread across Northern Ireland and into Southwest England and Wales today. This rain will continue east overnight, with snow affecting some northeastern parts of the UK. Becoming quite breezy.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain and snow will clear eastwards on Monday, with sunny spells and showers following in from the west. Tuesday will be similar, with a mix of sunny spells and showers, these wintry in the north. It will be breezy throughout.
