Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Today, for many, mild but rather cloudy with patchy drizzle, especially in the northwest where some heavier rain is likely later. However, some areas will have sunshine, perhaps eastern Scotland, northeastern England and southern and eastern parts of Northern Ireland and Wales most likely to benefit. Becoming windy in the north.

Tonight, the north, windy with persistent rain in parts of western Scotland. Further south, mainly dry, clear spells giving a few fog patches and a risk of local ground frost.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Wet and windy weather in the northwest Friday, transferring to the southeast on Saturday, brighter but colder weather following.
