Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cold start for many, then most places dry with long sunny spells. Cloudier in the southeast with patchy rain, and scattered showers in north and west Scotland. Feeling quite cold for many, but becoming milder in the far north. Tonight, there will be more cloud than Tuesday night, so not quite as cold, though still chilly for many.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Variable amounts of cloud on Thursday, with a little light rain or drizzle, especially over hills. Best of the brightness for central and northern England. Rain moving southeastwards on Friday followed by colder, clearer conditions with showers in the northwest.
