Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sleet or snow persisting for much of the day in the southeast. Sunny spells, wintry showers elsewhere, these heavy in places with hail and thunder, and some temporary snow accumulations. Tonight, wintry showers especially in the north and west, some sleet and snow also affecting the east for a time. Frosty away from windward coasts.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday, wintry showers, sunny spells. Longer spells of sleet or snow possible in the far north, perhaps also the far south. On Tuesday, sunshine and wintry showers but longer spells of rain or sleet in places, the snow becoming confined to higher ground. Overnight frosts.
