

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 25 Feb 2017

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain for northern areas at first, pushing further south through the day. Windy in parts of the north with a risk of local flooding in Cumbria. Brighter in Scotland in the afternoon. A cold night with scattered showers in the north. Milder and cloudier further south with rain clearing overnight, but more rain approaching from the north-west later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Dry at first, becoming cloudier and windy with rain spreading from the west. Persistent rain and gales along western exposed areas; east remaining dry. Turning showery on Monday, some thundery, with snow over hills. Feeling colder with overnight frosts, but milder further south.
