

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Thursday 10 Nov 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
A mainly cloudy day for most places with occasional drizzle and hill fog,  
although northwestern parts of the UK should keep some sunny spells until late  
afternoon. A band of more organised rain will affect first southwestern then  
other western areas through the afternoon, with some heavy bursts possible.  
Brisk southeasterly winds, especially around coasts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Remaining breezy with rain at times in northern and western parts of the UK on  
Saturday and early Sunday. Otherwise, staying mainly dry with some sunshine for  
many places, but overnight mist and low cloud too. Continuing mild for November,  
particularly in sheltered western areas.
