Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Cooler generally, with the north of the country wet and windy. Conditions improving later, with sunny intervals but also sharp showers following into western UK; affecting parts of western Scotland and Northern Ireland in particular. It will be drier with some sunshine further south over much of England and Wales after morning showers ease eastwards.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunshine and showers on Sunday, leading into a colder night with frost possible into Monday. Becoming wetter and windier into the new working week, with gales possible in the exposed north. The southeast of the country will see drier weather, though cloudier than of late.
