

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 08 Jul 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Early low cloud and mist in some eastern parts will gradually burn back to the North Sea coast, leaving another generally fine, very warm day across the UK in lengthy sunny periods. Overnight it should remain dry, aside from patchy drizzle reaching the far north of Scotland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Very warm and sunny for most on Tuesday, with low cloud in some eastern parts again dispersing. Cooler and cloudier in the far north, perhaps with the odd spot of drizzle. A little cloudier and less warm on Wednesday, especially in the east, although still with some sunny spells.
