Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A bitterly cold day with a raw easterly wind. Outbreaks of rain, sleet and snow initially in the southwest will spread to many other parts though the day. Northeast England and Eastern Scotland could see heavier snow later though. Driest in the Northwest.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday: Snow will gradually ease in northeast Scotland. Dry for a time elsewhere, though rather grey with little in the way of brightness. Rain, preceded by snow will move into the northwest later. Milder for most. Saturday: Sunshine and blustery showers for most though more persistent rain could clip far-southern counties for a time.
