Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Largely dry and sunny after a frosty start. Snow showers are expected over northern Scotland and Wales, spreading to the Midlands and eastern England through the day. Any showers in the southwest should die away as high cloud increases there. Generally cold with light winds.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Mainly dry with sunny spells on Friday, although snow showers will affect much of Scotland. Cloudy over southern England, possibly with some rain or snow in the far south. Saturday be largely dry and sunny. Some blustery snow showers are likely over northern Scotland with isolated showers elsewhere. Cold by day with widespread night-time frosts.
