

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Wednesday 07 Aug 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry for many with sunny spells. However some persistent rain at first for the northwest of Scotland and the west of Northern Ireland, although this turns increasingly showery later. Elsewhere, becoming increasingly cloudy, bringing the risk of a few scattered showers mainly during the afternoon. Showers then fade away, to leave a dry night with clear spells.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Dry and bright Thursday morning, although thicker cloud and outbreaks of rain move into Northern Ireland by midday. Elsewhere, clouds will build, again bringing the risk of further showers. Mostly cloudy on Friday, with outbreaks of rain clearing east, followed by sunny spells.
