

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 06 Aug 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunshine and showers, with some locally torrential and thundery downpours likely, especially in eastern Britain this afternoon where there may be some localised flooding. Northern Ireland will stay mostly dry. Heavy showers will continue this evening in some eastern areas, but becoming mostly dry elsewhere. Outbreaks of rain will probably reach the far southwest of England later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will see rain spreading east across southern Britain, rather persistent at times. Elsewhere, there will be bright spells, but also scattered slow-moving heavy showers, especially in northeastern areas. Patchy rain in southern areas easing during Wednesday, with some warm brighter periods elsewhere.
