Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Showery rain across the north this morning, but dry and bright in the south. The showers will spread into southeastern areas through the day, with the heaviest on the east coast. Some of these may turn thundery. The southwest is likely to stay dry all day. Becoming drier in all areas but the northwest overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
On Sunday morning cloud and rain will spread into the northwest and last much of the day, with the south mainly dry. Monday sees more rain in Northern Ireland and Scotland, but southern areas should have a drier brighter day.
