Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain will affect many areas at first, although the southeast of England and Northern Ireland will start mainly dry with some brightness possible. Rain will spread eastwards later and clear from the west. Overnight rain will gradually clear from eastern areas, but some showers will spread to western Scotland later. Otherwise mainly dry with clear spells and light winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Most places will be dry on Wednesday with cloud breaking to give some decent sunny periods through the day. Feeling warm with light winds. Then dry on Thursday with some good sunny periods and warm or very warm southerly breezes.
