Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Thickening cloud and spells of snow spreading across much of England and Wales. Scotland and Northern Ireland will continue very cold but should be mainly dry with a good deal of sunshine. Bitter northeasterly winds across the UK bringing significant wind chill. Overnight cloud and snow spreading across Northern Ireland and southern Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A cloudy day on Monday with some mainly light snow at times across most parts of the UK. Bitter easterly winds. Cloudy and mostly dry but very windy on Tuesday bringing severe wind chill. However, a band of rain, sleet and snow is expected across the southwest.
