Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain across Scotland and Northern Ireland will sink southwards across England and Wales during the day. The rain will freeze on sub-zero surfaces, giving ice problems across northern England and after dark it will turn to snow over much of central England and east Wales. Mild in the north but very cold further south.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Cloudy and mild with rain at times for Scotland and Northern Ireland. England and Wales will remain very cold with further sleet, snow and freezing rain, especially in central parts. Southeast parts of England will have a severe frost by Saturday morning with some freezing fog.
