

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 10 Sep 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Starting very mild and humid. Spells of occasionally heavy rain will move eastwards on brisk winds, before fresher and brighter conditions spread from western parts later. Remaining windy overnight, particularly towards northwestern UK. Some clear spells are likely, but also some heavy pulses of rain.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Wet and increasingly windy on Sunday across northern UK, with gale-force winds towards the northwest. Drier further south, with sunny intervals as well as blustery showers, some heavy with thunder. Becoming very windy by Monday with blustery showers and spells of rain. Gales are likely in many parts, with the strongest winds towards northwestern UK.
