Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 06 October to 0000 UTC Tuesday 07 October 2014

General Situation

A frontal swathe of wet and very windy weather will move eastwards across the United Kingdom today, followed by showery but calmer conditions from the west. The wet and windy weather is then expected to linger across the far northeast of Britain throughout Tuesday, while the close proximity of low pressure will keep elsewhere rather showery.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Moderate at first in Moray Firth, otherwise rough or very rough.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, backing easterly 7 to severe gale 9, then veering

southwesterly 5 or 6 later in south.

Rough or very rough, becoming high in east.

Rain at times.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 7 or gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6 later, then variable 3 or 4 in south.

Rough or very rough.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in south, otherwise southeasterly 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8, then southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming high for a time in far northeast.

Rain in north, but mainly fair in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, veering south 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough later.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeasterly 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.
Fair at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeasterly veering southwesterly 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, thundery for a time.
Mainly good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, then veering southwesterly 5 or 6 later.
Smooth, becoming moderate or rough.
Fair at first, then rain for a time, showers later.
Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 5 to 7.
Moderate.
Thundery showers.
Mainly good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering west or southwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight at first in east, otherwise moderate or rough.
Fair at first, then rain for a time, thundery showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or southwest 5 or 6.
Moderate.
Thundery showers.
Mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South 7 to severe gale 9, veering west or southwest 4 or 5.
Very rough at first in west, otherwise moderate or rough.
Rain at first, then thundery showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later near Isles of Scilly.
Moderate, but rough in far west.
Thundery showers.
Mainly good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in west, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.
Very rough at first in west, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain at first, then thundery showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 4 or 5, veering west 5 or 6, then backing southwest 5 to 7 later.
Moderate, occasionally rough in far west.
Thundery showers.
Mainly good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest 5 or 6, then becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.
Very rough at first in west, otherwise moderate or rough.
Rain at first, then thundery showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic becoming westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, then backing southwesterly 5 to 7 later.
Moderate, occasionally slight.
Thundery showers.
Mainly good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest 5 or 6, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Very rough at first in northwest, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight later.
Rain at first, then showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming west 5 or 6, then backing south later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, thundery at first.
Mainly good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Rain at first, then showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming west 5 or 6, then backing south later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate, occasionally slight later.
Rain at first, then thundery showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwest 4 or 5, then backing southeast later.
Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 in North Channel, veering southwesterly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate, occasionally slight later.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwest 4 or 5, then backing southeast later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers at first.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 in west, veering southwesterly 5 or 6, then backing southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Very rough at first in south and west, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming south 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers at first.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 at first in southwest, veering southwest 5 or 6 then backing southeast 3 or 4 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly becoming variable 3 or 4, but becoming easterly 5 to 7 in far north, then cyclonic 6 to gale 8 later in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough in far north.

Showers, then rain in north.

Good, becoming moderate in north.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 at first in southwest, veering southwest 5 or 6 then backing southeast 3 or 4 later.

Very rough or high, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly becoming variable 3 or 4, but becoming easterly 5 to 7 in far north, then cyclonic 6 to gale 8 later in north.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in far north.

Showers, then rain in north.

Good, becoming moderate in north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A deep and complex low south of Iceland will bring a strengthening southeasterly flow to Shetland water through Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southerly gale force 8 imminent, backing Southeasterly severe gale force 9 later. Issued at 0341GMT on Sunday 5th October.

Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 later in northeast.
Rough or very rough, becoming high later in east.
Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate or poor later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 06 Oct until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 07 Oct:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9.
Very rough or high.
Occasional rain.
Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 to 7, increasing 7 to gale 8 by dawn, veering west around midday and decreasing 4 to 5, backing southwest in the evening, locally 6 and gusty near showers.

Slight, becoming mainly rough overnight, decreasing moderate to rather rough Monday evening.

Rain by dawn, locally heavy, clearing around midday scattered showers developing in the evening, locally heavy with a risk of thunder.

Very good, becoming moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 4 to 5, locally 6 and gusty near showers, backing southwest to south in the evening.

Moderate to rather rough with a swell.

Scattered showers, locally heavy with a risk of thunder.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

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
