Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
A misty start for most, then mainly dry with some sunshine. Mist will linger around some western and northeastern coasts with a few showers likely over S.England and the Midlands from dawn onwards. E.Scotland will be more generally cloudy. Showers, possibly heavy and thundery, are likely to develop inland during the day. Very warm and humid across England and east Wales. Temperatures around normal elsewhere.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday will be mostly fine with sunny spells, although some showers are likely to develop during the day. Staying very warm in the south. Again mostly fine and warm on Saturday, some showers over Scotland.
