Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Much of England and Wales will be largely dry but often cloudy, after a misty, sunny start in places. Some sunny intervals and scattered showers elsewhere, the showers mostly in the northwest. Later, rain will reach the far northwest, spreading southeastwards overnight, reaching Wales and much of England by morning. Temperatures will be near normal.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Rain will clear from the southeast early Sunday afternoon, otherwise sunshine and scattered showers. Some of the showers in the northwest will be heavy and thundery. On Monday, scattered showers in the northeast, mostly dry with sunny intervals towards the southwest. Temperatures mostly near average.
