Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain in the south gradually clearing eastwards this morning, leaving a bright day with scattered showers, heavy and persistent at times across northern and central parts and also wintry in the east as a brisk northerly wind develops. Overnight continuing in the east, but elsewhere largely dry but turning cold and frosty.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A cold and bright day on Saturday with wintry showers, which will mainly be along eastern coasts. A cold night for many Saturday night into Sunday, but a band of rain will reach Northern Ireland overnight, and spread eastwards across the UK during Sunday, with milder air following.
